**Get All The Facts**

The new boss was determined to rid the company of all slackers. On a tour of the facilities, the CEO noticed a guy leaning against a wall. The room was full of workers and he wanted to let them know that he meant business. He asked the guy, "How much money do you make a week?"

A little surprised, the young man looked at him and said, "I make \$400.00 a week. Why?"

The CEO said, "Wait right here." He walked back to his office, came back in two minutes, and handed the guy \$1,600.00 in cash and said, "Here's four weeks pay. Now GET OUT and don't come back."

The story above illustrates the necessity of getting all the facts before we make a decision. This extremely important in the area of our salvation. Most of the differences in various churches and their answer to how we are saved result from a failure to get the whole picture.

When studying the bible we must find all the facts that God's word gives us before we jump to a conclusion about whether we are saved or not.

For example, some might take the scripture which says that God is not willing for any to perish (2 Pet 3:9) and conclude that everyone will be saved (universal salvation).

Others take scriptures which talk of our faith saving us (Luke 7:50, Eph 2:8) and conclude that we are saved by faith alone, without considering scriptures that clearly state that obedience is necessary for our salvation (Heb 5:9, Jas 2:14-26).

We must find all the facts about salvation before we make any conclusions about whether we are saved or not. You can look up: save, saves, saved, and salvation in a concordance or in a computer bible program such as e-sword, download free at (<http://www.e-sword.net/>) and find all the scriptures which deal with salvation.

If we see just a few pixels of a picture it is impossible to know what the picture is, but as more pixels are added we get a clearer picture until we finally get the last pixel and then we have the complete picture.

Please don't base your salvation on an incomplete picture of what the bible says about the topic.
